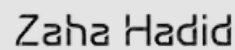

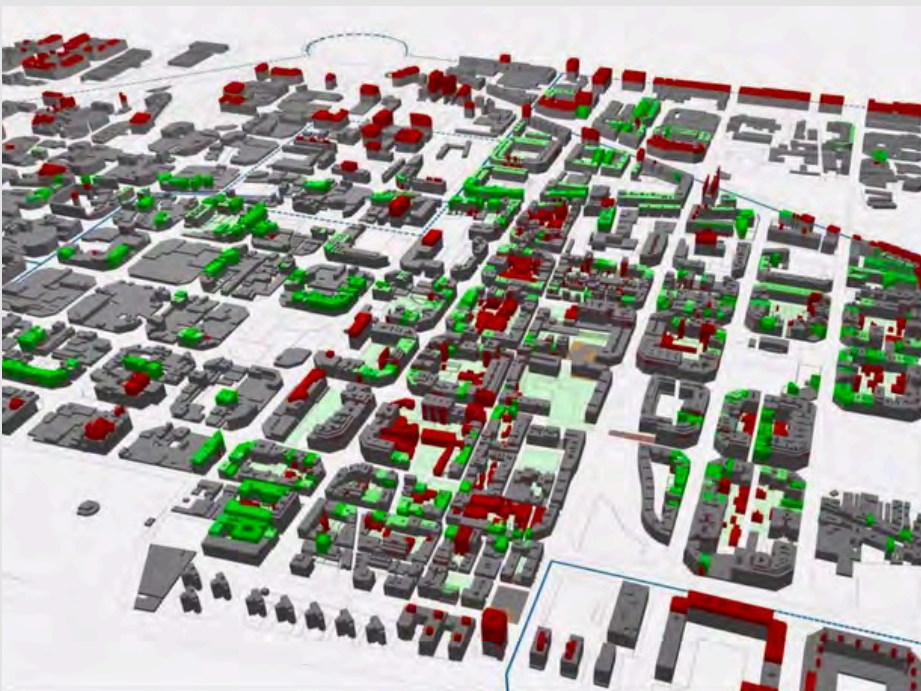

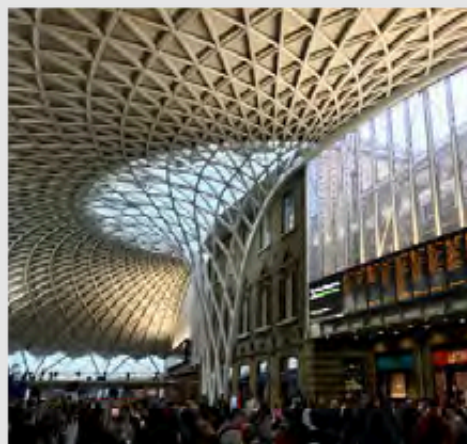

Serpentine Pavillion by Minsuk Cho, Mass Studies

Archipelagic Void, the Pavilion is composed of five 'islands', each structure is unique in size, height and form.

The curving edges of the individual roofs are conjoined by a steel ring which references traditional Korean houses that feature a madang, an open courtyard located at the centre.



Battersea Power Station

At its peak, Battersea Power Station was supplying a fifth of London's electricity.
